

ORDINANCE NO. 42-97

An Ordinance to appropriate the amount of \$25,500.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of constructing a parking lot to the North of the front of Jeffrey Mansion to replicate the original parking spaces forfeited from the entry drive.

WHEREAS, the closing of the drive from Parkview Avenue into Jeffrey Park has caused the elimination of parking on the Jeffrey Mansion entry drive and,

WHEREAS, the present ten (10) space lot is not adequate to support the parking needs of Jeffrey Mansion.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$25,500.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of constructing a 16 space parking lot to the North of the front of Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the construction of a 16 space parking lot.

Section 3. That the contract authorized herein shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder and in accordance with law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to commence the construction of the parking lot as soon as legally possible, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
