

ORDINANCE NO. 5-97

An Ordinance to appropriate supplemental operating funds for the purchase of street lights to replace those which have been damaged and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the sum of \$2500.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and is transferred to Street Lighting Account #01-340-133, Repairs and Maintenance for the purchase of street lights.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to replace damaged street lights, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
