ORDINANCE NO. 55-97

An Ordinance to appropriate the amount of \$53,300.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of improvements to the 6 acre athletic field space at Wolfe Park.

WHEREAS, the City Of Bexley currently holds the lease for this space at Wolfe Park and the City of Columbus has approved this work.

WHEREAS, the work will entail rock clearing, grading, seeding and fertilizing the portion covered by the lease.

WHEREAS, the cost will be shared by the various involved institutions; City of Bexley, Bexley Schools, Capital University.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$53,300.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of preparing the leased portion of Wolfe Park for youth athletics.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the improvements to the leased portion of Wolfe Park.

Section 3. That the contract authorized herein shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder and in accordance with law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to commence the improvements to the leased portion of Wolfe Park as soon as legally possible, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
