An Ordinance to amend Section 1042.03 of the Bexley Codified Ordinances to increase the reconnect charge for water, sewer and sanitation services from \$40.00 to \$80.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 1042.03 of the Bexley Codified Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

1042.03 LATE PAYMENTS; PENALTY; RE-CONNECTION CHARGE.

Water, SEWER AND SANITATION bills which are not paid by the date on which they become due as thereon shown shall be considered delinquent, and the consumer shall be liable to a penalty of ten percent of the amount due on the delinquent bill. If such bills together with such penalty, <sup>are</sup> not paid within ten days after notice of such delinquency, water, SEWER AND SANITATION serviceS shall be discontinued and a charge of ~~forty dollars (\$40.00)~~ EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$80.00) shall be collected before such serviceS ~~is~~ ARE restored.

Any notice required by this section shall be deemed sufficient if mailed by regular mail to the premises to which such notice relates or the address to which the water, SEWER AND SANITATION bill is mailed.

Section 2. That Section 1042.03 as presently in effect is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
