An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,250.00 from the ~~unencumbered Sewer~~ <sup>unencumbered Sewer</sup> Fund and \$1,250.00 from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of purchasing a computer upgrade for the Auditor's Department file server.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$1,250.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund and \$1,250.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the ~~unencumbered Water~~ <sup>unencumbered Water</sup> Fund for the purpose of purchasing a computer upgrade for the Auditor's Department file server.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to upgrade security of the file server in the Auditor's Department and thereby assure the safety of all electronically stored files and to comply with the State of Ohio Auditor's recommendations.
