

ORDINANCE NO. 62-97

An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,860.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of upgrading the Police Department computer operating system and to provide technical support services.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$1,860.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of upgrading the Police Department computer operating system and to provide technical support services.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to upgrade the Police Department computer operating system prior to January 1, 1998, to ensure continuous technical support services.
