An Ordinance to place a moratorium on the hiring of all full-time and part-time salaried and hourly employees, subject to the approval of Council, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That no full-time or part-time salaried or hourly employees, including both new and replacement hires, shall be employed by the City without the approval of Council until and unless this Ordinance shall be revoked or amended. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City may employ temporary, seasonal and casual employees to the extent funds have been appropriated for such purpose.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to impose such moratorium at the earliest possible date, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
