<u>Section 3</u>. That \$18,191.40 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund as follows:

Section 4. That \$6,600.00 is appropriated from the unencumbered Refuse Fund as follows:

11-370-51010 Salaries and Wages \$6,600.00

<u>Section 5</u>. That \$4,420.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Pool Fund as follows:

14-550-51010 Salaries & Wages \$4,420.00

<u>Section 6</u>. That \$25,000.00 is transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Police Pension Fund.

<u>Section 7</u>. That the appropriation level for the Capital Improvements Fund is reduced as follows:
