

ODINANCE NO 67 -97

An Ordinance to appropriate \$56,663.45 from the unencumbered General Fund, to appropriate \$11,600.00 from the unencumbered Street Construction and Repair Fund, to appropriate \$18,191.40 from the unencumbered Sewer Fund, to appropriate \$6,600.00 from the unencumbered Refuse Fund, to appropriate \$4,420.00 from the unencumbered Pool Fund, to transfer \$25,000.00 from the General Fund to the Police Pension Fund, and to reduce the appropriation level of the Capital Improvements Fund by \$123,000.00

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$56,663.45 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund as follows:

Section 2. That \$12,600.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Street Construction and Repair Fund as follows:

03-380-51010	Salaries & Wages	\$ 5,000.00
03-380-51190	Contract/Professional	<u>6,600.00</u>
		\$11,600.00

Section 3. That \$18,191.40 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund as follows:

10-360-51190	Contract with Columbus	\$18,191.40
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Section 4. That \$6,600.00 is appropriated from the unencumbered Refuse Fund as follows:

11-370-51010	Salaries and Wages	\$6,600.00
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Section 5. That \$4,420.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Pool Fund as follows:

14-550-51010	Salaries & Wages	\$4,420.00
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Section 6. That \$25,000.00 is transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Police Pension Fund.

Section 7. That the appropriation level for the Capital Improvements Fund is reduced as follows:

13-855-51430	Streets Overlay	\$(123,000.00)
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Section 8. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace health and safety and shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
