

ORDINANCE NO. 68-97

An Ordinance to amend Section 262.02(c)(14) regarding vacation credit for prior public employment and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 262.02(c)(14) of the Codified Ordinances be amended by the addition of subdivision D. as follows:

(D). Credit for Prior Service. Upon the approval of the Mayor, an employee may receive credit in calculating the number of days of vacation for prior service with another municipality within the State of Ohio.

Section 2. That, except as amended hereby, Section 262.02 of the Codified Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to ratify vacation days granted to certain employees of the City during calendar year 1997, and shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
