An Ordinance to authorize specific fund transfers provided by Ordinance No. 63-97.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 63-97 made appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the City during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 63-97 provided for transfers from the unencumbered General Fund in the aggregate amount of \$375,000 but did not designate the funds to which such transfers were to be made; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to authorize such transfers with specificity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the transfers from the unencumbered General Fund provided by Ordinance No. 63-97 are hereby authorized as follows:

Recreation Fund	\$200,000
Street Maintenance and Repair Fund	100,000
Swimming Pool Fund	25,000
Police Pension Fund	50,000

Section 2. That the monies transferred to the funds specified in Section 1 are hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying current expenses and other expenditures of the City attributable to such funds during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1998.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
