

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 107-98

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to fill the position of Administrative Assistant to the Mayor when it becomes vacant, to establish a salary, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Council has previously placed a freeze on hiring by all departments; and,

WHEREAS, the Administrative Assistant to the Mayor position will be vacant and this Council has determined that it is in the public interest to maintain the position. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to hire an Administrative Assistant to the Mayor.

Section 2. That the Administrative Assistant to the Mayor will be paid on the anniversary date of hire to the position an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment in the position as follows:

Starting rate	\$27,500
January 1, 2000	\$29,800
January 1, 2001	\$32,500
January 1, 2002	\$35,000

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to fill the position of Administrative Assistant to the Mayor upon its becoming vacant, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
