An Ordinance to appropriate \$105,190 from the Capital Improvements Fund for various capital improvements during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1998 and to authorize contracts therefor in accordance with law.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$105,190 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the following purposes:
