

Ordinance 43-98

ORDINANCE NO. 43 -98

An Ordinance to appropriate \$8,000 from the unencumbered Sewer Fund for the purpose of paying for the televising of two damaged sewer lines and for the repair of a collapsed 10 inch sewer line in Main Street between S. Dawson Avenue and S. Cassady Avenue.

WHEREAS, problems have developed in two sewer lines in the City of Bexley; and,

WHEREAS, it was necessary to investigate those lines with television equipment that the City does not own and had to contract for; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to immediately repair the 10 inch collapsed sewer line in Main Street. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$8,000 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer fund for the purpose of paying for the televising of two damaged sewer lines and for the repair of a collapsed 10 inch sewer line in Main Street between S. Dawson Avenue and S. Cassady Avenue.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to have the 10 inch collapsed sewer line repaired at the earliest possible date.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to repair the collapsed line and restore flow in the line at the earliest possible date, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
