ORDINANCE NO. 46-98

An Ordinance to appropriate \$7,200.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing six additional residential street lights.

WHEREAS, a need for six additional residential street lights has been identified; and,

WHEREAS, the installation of these lights will deplete the City's entire stock of lights; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have extra lights on hand to replace lights damaged by motor vehicles and other accidents. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$7,200.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing six additional residential street lights.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
