An Ordinance to appropriate ^{2,300.00} ~~\$1,600.00~~ from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of funding the 1998 Labor Day Block Party and other special City activities and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of ^{2,300.00} ~~\$1,600.00~~ should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of funding the 1998 Labor Day Block Party and other special City activities.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to begin preparing for the Labor Day Block Party, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
