

Ordinance 57-98

ORDINANCE NO. 57 -98

An Ordinance to authorize the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$769,144.34 from various sources for the purpose of paying for work completed in the 1998 Street Project.

WHEREAS, the 1998 Street Project is being paid for by funding from various sources including Federal, County, and City of Bexley programs, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Bexley to receive funds from the various agencies and pay those funds to contractors after completion of the work, and

WHEREAS, the funding sources and estimated costs of each component of the 1998 Street Project are detailed in Exhibit A which is attached to, and made a part of, this Ordinance. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the funding sources and the expenditures of those funds in the amount of \$769,144.34 for the 1998 Street Project as detailed in Exhibit A which is attached to, and made a part of, this Ordinance, are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor, after receipt of proper documentation and invoicing, are authorized to pay the funds for work completed in the 1998 Street Project as detailed in Exhibit A.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to appropriate the funding received from Federal, County, and City of Bexley programs to pay for the 1998 Street Project, and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
