An Ordinance to appropriate \$3,605.36 from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the cost of services provided by the Walter H. Drane Company relating to the codification of Ordinances from May 1, 1997 to June 1, 1998.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$3,605.360 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the cost of services provided by the Walter H. Drane Company relating to the codification of Ordinances from May 1, 1997 to June 1, 1998.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of paying for these services in a timely manner, and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
