ORDINANCE NO. 62 - 98

An Ordinance to appropriate \$3,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the payment of expenses arising from the enforcement of Code Section 1490.15(B) which permits the removal of junk and/or the cutting of rank growth of weeds and grass when the owner, operator, or occupant fails to comply with a Code Enforcement Notice.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$3,000.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the payment of expenses arising from the enforcement of Code Section 1490.15(B) which permits the removal of junk and/or the cutting of rank growth of weeds and grass when the owner, operator, or occupant fails to comply with a Code Enforcement Notice.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
