An Ordinance to appropriate \$3,000.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing a dedicated computer work station and software which will connect the City of Bexley to the Internet and allow for the maintenance and updating of the City's web site.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$3,000.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing a dedicated computer work station and software which will connect the City of Bexley to the Internet and allow for the maintenance and updating of the City's web site.
