

Ordinance 77-98

ORDINANCE NO. 77-98

An Ordinance to appropriate \$10,000.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of engineering services related to the redesign of the railing on the Broad Street bridge over Alum Creek, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with Sticklen Belsheim for the required engineering services, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Broad Street bridge is currently being replaced; and,

WHEREAS, the bridge serves as a main gateway to Bexley; and,

WHEREAS, it is important that the bridge railing be of a design that is complimentary to Bexley; and,

WHEREAS, the firm of Sticklen Belsheim has designed the replacement bridge and, therefore, is most qualified to design the railing. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$10,000.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of engineering services related to the redesign of the railing on the Broad Street bridge over Alum Creek.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor should be, and hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract with Sticklen Belsheim for the required engineering services.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete the engineering design no later than September 30, 1998, and that this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
