

Ordinance 78-98

ORDINANCE NO. 78-98

An Ordinance to appropriate \$2,600.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing thermoplastic pavement markings for the north curb lane of Main Street and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the north curb lane of Main Street is being repaved as part of the Main Street Signalization and Lighting Project; and,

WHEREAS, the existing pavement markings will be removed as part of the repaving; and,

WHEREAS, the pavement markings are essential. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$2,600.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing thermoplastic pavement markings for the north curb lane of Main Street.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to replace the pavement markings immediately after paving to facilitate traffic movement and safety, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
