

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 88 -98

An Ordinance to appropriate ^{3,250.00} ~~\$3,000.00~~ from the unencumbered ^{General} ~~Capital~~ ~~Improvements~~ Fund for the purchase of street banners for the new signal and lighting poles on Main Street.

WHEREAS, existing street banners do not fit on the new signal and lighting poles on Main Street; and,

WHEREAS, the street banner program has been in existence since 1988, and has projected a positive image for Main Street and the City as a whole, and should be continued. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of ^{3,250.00} ~~\$3,000.00~~ should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered ~~Capital~~ ~~Improvements~~ Fund for the purchase of street banners to replace existing street banners. ^{General}

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to provide the banners at the completion of the signalization and lighting pole installation, and that this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
