

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 90 - 98

An Ordinance to increase the water rate charged by the City of Bexley and to authorize the transfer of \$33,000 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Water Fund

WHEREAS, by ordinance No. 60-81, this Council provided that water and sewer rates to be charged to the residents of the City of Bexley will be established by Council upon advice from the Water Department and dependent upon the needs of the City as determined by the costs to the City for the operation of the Water Department and the charges by the City of Columbus for water usage and sewer service; and

WHEREAS, the charges imposed on the City of Bexley by the City of Columbus will be substantially increased in 1999 which will necessitate a further increase in the rates to be assessed to the residents for water usage.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the water rate charged by the City of Bexley on all bills issued on or after January 1, 1999, shall be \$16.34 per 1000 cubic feet (MCF).

Section 2. That all existing Ordinances of the City of Bexley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
