

ORDINANCE NO. 3 -99

An Ordinance to appropriate \$6,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing five additional residential street lights.

WHEREAS, the underground wiring and installation of bases for the Drexel Avenue commercial area north of Main Street has been approved by the Ohio Department of Transportation; and,

WHEREAS, the installation of these lights is essential to lighting this area which has become dark due to the removal of the cobra head lights on Main Street; and,

WHEREAS, the City's portion of this project is the installation of the poles and luminaires. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$6,000.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing five additional street lights.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
