A resolution to proclaim support for passage of Issue 15, the Metro Parks Levy, which is being presented to the voters of Franklin County on May 4, 1999.

WHEREAS, Metro Parks is funded primarily through a property tax which has been supported in the past by the majority of voters in Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Parks tax levy will expire this year; now therefore,

Section 1. That the City of Bexley supports the passage of ISSUE 15, which is the Metro Parks 0.65 mill ten year levy, which is being submitted to the voters of Franklin County on May 4, 1999.
