

ORDINANCE NO. 10 -99

An Ordinance to appropriate \$31,221.50 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of reimbursing the Franklin County Engineer unexpended funds from the 1998 South Roosevelt Street Project.

Whereas, The Franklin County Engineer allocated \$220,000.00 to the City of Bexley for the purpose of installing new curbs and resurfacing South Roosevelt Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue; and,

Whereas, the actual cost of the project was \$188,778.50, which is \$31,221.50 less than the allocation. NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$31,221.50 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of reimbursing the Franklin County Engineer.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
