An Ordinance to appropriate \$212,900.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for capital improvements.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$212,900.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of the following:

a) Dump Truck	\$	50,000.00

c) Lease payment for cruisers 54,55 and 56	\$	21,000.00
d) Purchase three cruisers	\$	21,500.00
e) Video camera/recorder for cruiser #51	\$	1,000.00
f) Rebuild Chevy cruiser	\$	6,000.00
g) Shelter House	\$	15,000.00
h) Brick replacement work on Mansion walls	\$	4,000.00
i) Iron gate at garage court	\$	2,400.00
j) Tables for Mansion	\$	2,500.00
k) Application server/Internet proxy server	\$	3,500.00
l) Internet service (City) – installation service	\$	6,000.00
m) High speed printer – Auditors office	\$	9,000.00
n) Color laser printer – Recreation Department	\$	3,000.00
o) Audio/Visual equipment and training classroom	\$	<u>3,000.00</u>
Total		\$ 212,900.00

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of goods and services as specified above.

Section 3. That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
