

ORDINANCE NO. 17 -99

An Ordinance to appropriate \$68,500.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of purchasing the necessary information systems equipment to insure compliance with the year 2000, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$68,500.00 is hereby appropriated from unencumbered General Fund for the purchase of the following:

- a) Replace Recreation Department telephone system and update current City Hall/Police Department telephone system. \$ 35,000.00
- b) 20 new computers \$ 30,000.00
- c) Licenses and software upgrades for 1999 \$ 3,500.00
- \$ 68,500.00**

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of goods and services as specified above.

Section 3. That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
