WHEREAS, The City has requested services for the Main Street project that were not included in the original scope of the project; NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$27,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated form the unencumbered General fund for the purpose of paying Sticklen-Belsheim Engineering for work related to the Main and Broad Street Signalization and Street Lighting Project.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
