

RESOLUTION NO. 22 -99

A Resolution authorizing the Police Department to hire an Animal Control Officer to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of the incumbent Animal Control Officer and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Council has previously placed a freeze on hiring by all departments; and

WHEREAS, the Animal Control position will become vacant at the close of business on October 8, 1999, and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it is in the public interest to maintain a full-time Animal Control Officer; **NOW, THEREFORE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. The Police Department is hereby authorized to hire an Animal Control Officer to fill the position, that will become vacant due to a resignation, at the close of business on October 8, 1999.

Section 2. That this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to employ a full-time Animal Control Officer at the earliest possible date, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
