An Ordinance to accept a gift of \$10,000 from the Bexley Heritage Foundation to fund development of a landscape master plan, to appropriate \$10,000 for such purpose, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute an agreement on behalf of the City with Myers Schmalenberger, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City hereby accepts a gift of \$10,000 from the Bexley Heritage Foundation to fund development of a master landscape plan for the City, said funds to be deposited in a designated account, and appropriates \$10,000 from the account for such purpose.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an agreement on behalf of the City with Myers Schmalenberger in the form attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance, together with such changes, if any, approved by the City Attorney.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to complete the plan for the fall planting season, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
