

ORDINANCE NO. 45-99

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 26-99, which appropriated \$12,000.00 for the purpose of paying for Hepatitis B vaccinations for Police Department staff and the City Hall Custodian, to include as eligible employees, all employees who have reasonable or potential occupational exposure to blood or other potential occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 26-99 appropriated \$12,000.00 for the purpose of paying for Hepatitis B vaccinations for Police Department staff and the City Hall custodian; and,

as determined by the Mayor and the Department Heads and the Health Commissioner

WHEREAS, ~~it has been found that~~ other city employees may have reasonable or potential occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials, and therefore, should have hepatitis B vaccinations made available to them; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 26-99 should be and hereby is amended to include as eligible employees all employees who may have reasonable or potential occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance, said emergency being the need to provide vaccinations, as soon as possible, and shall go into effect upon its passage upon approval by the Mayor.
