ORDINANCE NO. 54 -99

An Ordinance to appropriate \$2,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of hiring Sharon Patterson to complete Records Retention for the Service Department and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is required that all City Departments complete Records Retention.

WHEREAS, Sharon Patterson's knowledge of the City and in particular the Service Department, makes her the best person to complete Records Retention.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$2,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of hiring Sharon Patterson to complete Records Retention for the Service Department.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, the need being to complete Records during the month of August, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


