An Ordinance to appropriate \$3,400.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of providing additional funds for vehicle fuel in the accounts that do not have sufficient funds, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the amount of \$3,400.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of providing additional funds for vehicle fuel in the following accounts that do not have sufficient funds:

Garage	\$ 500.00
Parks	\$ 500.00
Streets	\$1,000.00
City Hall	\$ 200.00
Water	\$ 200.00
Refuse	\$1,000.00

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety, the need being to pay outstanding invoices, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
