

ORDINANCE 57 -99

An Ordinance to appropriate \$27,592.60 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund to pay a portion of the design costs related to the Broad Street Bridge railing and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, it was necessary to hire Sticklen-Belsheim Engineers to design the changes needed to accommodate a new railing on the Broad Street Bridge; and,

WHEREAS, The Franklin County Commissioners allocated and sent the amount of \$27,592.60 to the City of Bexley for partial payment for the design, and said amount has been deposited in the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund. NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$27,592.60 should be and hereby is appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying Sticklen Belsheim for engineering services related to the redesign of the Broad Street Bridge railing.

Section 2. That this is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, the emergency being the need to pay an outstanding invoice, and shall go into force and effect upon its signing by the Mayor.
