An Ordinance to appropriate \$3,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the firm of Reminger and Reminger, special counsel to the City, for matters relating to development of a right-of-way policy, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$3,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying Reminger and Reminger, special counsel to the City.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, the emergency being the need to complete the City's right-of-way policy as soon as possible, and shall go into force and effect upon its signing by the Mayor.
