**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That the amount of \$4,500.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of funding community cookouts.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to pay for supplies currently needed, and that this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
