An Ordinance to appropriate ~~\$12,650.00~~ from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for materials and installation of landscaping in two traffic calming circles, one at the intersection of Powell and Gould Road and one at the intersection of Dale and Gould Road.

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus has installed two traffic calming circles on Gould Road, one half of which are in the City of Bexley, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley has requested that the landscaping of the circles be completed by Bexley with partial reimbursement from Columbus, and

WHEREAS, a landscape plan has been developed by Myers Schmalenberger in conjunction with the Bexley Tree and Public Garden Commission and the Bexley Heritage Foundation, and accepted by the City of Bexley and the City of Columbus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

\$ 3,400.00

Section 1. That the amount of ~~\$12,650.00~~ should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for materials and installation of landscaping in two traffic calming circles on Gould Road.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
