An Ordinance to amend Section 648.10 of the General Offenses Code to extend the curfew for minors to 6:00 a.m.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Section 648.10 of the General Offenses Code is hereby amended as follows:

648.10 MINOR'S CURFEW; TRUANCY.

(a) No minor under the age of twelve years shall loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in or upon the public streets or other public places or upon private property, except upon private property where the minor resides and with the permission of his parent or guardian, during the period between 10:00 p.m. to 5:30 6:00 a.m. of the following day, unless accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor or unless such minor is on an emergency errand directed by his parent or guardian, or on legitimate business directed by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

(b) No minor under the age of eighteen years shall loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in or upon the public streets or other public places or upon private property, except upon private property where the minor resides and with the permission of the parent or guardian of such minor, during the period between 12:00 midnight and 4:30 6:00 a.m. of the following day, unless accompanied by the minor's parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or unless such minor is on an emergency errand or legitimate business at the direction of the parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

(c) No parent, guardian or person having the care, custody or control of any minor shall permit such minor to violate any of the provisions of this section.

(d) No person shall aid, abet, influence or encourage any child under the age of eighteen years to:

- (1) Violate subsection (a) hereof;
- (2) Violate subsection (b) hereof;
- (3) Be truant from home when such child has been reported as truant from home to the police or a Municipal official; or

(4) Be truant from school when the laws of this State require such child's attendance in school.

(e) Whoever, being an adult, violates any of the provisions of this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Punishment shall be as provided in Section 698.02.

(f) Whoever, being a minor, violates any of the provisions of this section shall be dealt with in accordance with Juvenile Court law and procedure.

<u>Section 2</u>. That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after the earliest period permitted by law.
