An Ordinance to grant an additional 117.25 hours of injury leave with pay to Samuel Young, an employee of the City of Bexley.

**WHEREAS**, Samuel Young had a service related injury that required Mr. Young to be off work 117.25 hours beyond the 120 days of injury leave allowed by Article 23, Section 23.1 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Bexley and Ohio Council 8 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees AFL-CIO Local 3838; and

**WHEREAS**, Article 23, Section 23.1 provides that "injury leave with pay may be extended by the Mayor upon such terms as the City in its discretion may establish;" and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Young has requested 117.25 hours additional injury leave, and

**WHEREAS**, City Council is authorized by Article 23, Section 23.1 to establish the terms upon which additional injury leave will be granted.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That Samuel Young should be and hereby is granted 117.25 hours additional injury leave.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Dear City Counsel Members:

I am writing to request that my sick leave hours be returned to my sick leave account. I originally was injured on April 13, 1995, and had to have surgery February 26, 1996. I was off work until August 5, 1996. Injury leave was used for this period off work.
