

ORDINANCE NO. 10-00

An Ordinance to increase the sewer rate and the water rate charged by the City of Bexley and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That, commencing January 1, 2000, the sewer rate charged by the City of Bexley to customers billed quarterly shall be at the rate of \$ 28.26 per 1,000 cubic feet, and the water rate charged by the City of Bexley to customers billed quarterly shall be at the rate of \$18.78 per 1000 cubic feet.

Section 2. That, commencing January 1, 2000, the sewer rate charged by the City of Bexley to customers billed monthly shall be at the rate of \$ 28.26 per 1,000 cubic feet, and the water rate charged by the City of Bexley to customers billed monthly shall be at the rate of \$18.78 per 1000 cubic feet.

Section 3. That all existing ordinances of the City of Bexley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance.



That this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of collecting said increase rate effective January 1, 2000, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
