

ORDINANCE NO. 102-00

An Ordinance to repeal Section 820.08 of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code effective February 1, 2001.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3717 establishes a uniform food safety code and licensing system for both food service operations and retail food establishments effective February 1, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Health and Ohio Department of Agriculture have delegated licensing and inspection responsibilities within the City to the Bexley Board of Health; and

WHEREAS, as of February 1, 2001, the City will no longer license food establishments pursuant to Section 820.08; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Bexley Board of Health has established a schedule of license fees to be effective on February 1, 2001;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 820.08 of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after February 1, 2001.
