

ORDINANCE NO. 12 -00

An ordinance to appropriate \$15,100.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for police wages and overtime associated with the Juvenile Task force.

WHEREAS, The City of Bexley is concerned about the safety of its youth; and,

WHEREAS, many parents have expressed concern about the activities of youth who gather at businesses along Main Street on Friday and Saturday night; and,

WHEREAS, concerns have been raised regarding alcohol and substance abuse by youth; and,

WHEREAS, the Bexley Police Department has been approved for funding through the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant in the amount of \$10,000 with a 10% match by the City of Bexley; and,

WHEREAS, the grant funds may be used to pay for straight-time wages for police personnel to work on the Juvenile Task Force, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley will provide the 10% match and the additional monies required for the premium (overtime) portion of the cost of these officers. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That \$15,100.00 should be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund as follows:

01-200-51011	Police Overtime	\$4,000.00

Section 2. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
