

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 12 -00

An ordinance to appropriate \$46,186.96 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for police overtime associated with the Juvenile Task force and school crisis response training.

WHEREAS, The City of Bexley is concerned about the safety of its youth, both in and out of school; and,

WHEREAS, many parents have expressed concern about the activities of youth who gather at businesses along Main Street on Friday and Saturday night; and,

WHEREAS, concerns have been raised regarding alcohol and substance abuse by youth; and,

WHEREAS, the Bexley Police Department has requested funding through the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant in the amount of \$46,186.96 with a 10% match by the City of Bexley; and,

WHEREAS, the grant funds may be used to pay overtime for police personnel to work on the Juvenile Task Force and overtime related to school crisis response training, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley will provide the 10% match. NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY


Section 2. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
