

ORDINANCE NO. 17-00

An Ordinance to appropriate \$25,000.00 from the unencumbered Highway Fund for the purpose of purchasing road salt for the remainder of the year 2000.

WHEREAS, \$20,000.00 was appropriated in the Year 2000 Budget for the purchase of salt for the year 2000, and

WHEREAS, that amount has been expended due to winter conditions that utilized more salt than expected, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to purchase salt for the remainder of late winter 2000 and early winter 2001. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$25,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Highway Fund for the purchase of road salt.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
