

ORDINANCE NO. 25-00

An Ordinance to extend the current moratorium on demolitions to August 1, 2000 and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously imposed a moratorium on demolitions which expires by its terms on April 30, 2000; and

WHEREAS, this Council presently is considering Ordinance No. 8-00 to amend Chapter 1480 of the Building and Housing Code in its entirety, and this Council finds it necessary to extend the moratorium until August 1, 2000, in order to provide additional time for consideration of the pending Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the current moratorium on demolitions is hereby extended until August 1, 2000 on the terms and conditions set forth in Amended Ordinance No. 32-99.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of regulating demolitions pending consideration of a revised Zoning Code by this Council, and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
