

ORDINANCE NO. 27-00

An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,000,000.00 from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of purchasing and installing an automated water meter reading system and a water meter change out program, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,000,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of purchasing and installing an automated water meter reading system and a water meter change out program and to declare an emergency.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase and installation of the automated water meter reading system and water meter change out program.

Section 3. The contracts authorized herein, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder for each of the needed components.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, in order to commence with contract negotiations with the successful bidders at the earliest possible date, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
