

ORDINANCE NO. 28 -00By: Jed Morison

An Ordinance to appropriate \$128,240.71 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund, to appropriate 26,300.00 from the unencumbered Pool Fund and to appropriate \$11,700.00 from the unencumbered General Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That the sum of \$128,240.71 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing of the following:
