

ORDINANCE NO. 30-00

An Ordinance to amend Section 262.02(d) of the Administration Code regarding health insurance benefits of the Health Commissioner, such amendment to be effective May 1, 2000, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 262.02(d)(3) of the Administration Code is hereby amended as follows:

(A) Health Commissioner. The Health Commissioner shall be deemed a City employee, but shall only be furnished dental care insurance, life insurance, and Workers' Compensation benefits at the same level that is provided to Schedule I employees. Compensation of the Health Commissioner shall be as provided by the annual pay or ordinance. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Health Commissioner shall be furnished health care insurance on the terms set forth in Section 262.03(d)(1) for a period of up to six month, commencing May 1, 2000, and ending on the earlier of October 31, 2000, or the date on which the Health Commissioner is entitled to health insurance coverage from another employer.

Section 2. That existing Section 262.02(d)(3) is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to provide uninterrupted health insurance coverage to the Health Commissioner, and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, to be effective as of May 1, 2000.
